Health and Education Bond

This Security is also a diploma for a great future. It's a health and educational bond, for which we anticipate supplying goods and/or services to bondholders. Optionally, 7% p.a. interest is issued if subscribing bondholders return it at maturity, in twenty (20) years.

The Services are health related, in the [form of therapies](#) like ones used and taught 2000 years ago and more recently therapies used by Edgar Cayce; and/or hyperbaric oxygen therapy; and neuroscientific therapies health insurance may later cover. Services are expected to include alleviation of chronic ailments, including dementia, for which the medical system has not yet found simple solutions dreams or visions supply.

The Goods are books and courses based on [Practically Dreaming and Remote Viewing](#) on practical uses of dreams, and visions (first 2 in the series). Courses teach the practical use of dreams and visions plus the neuroscience behind the power of suggestion for responsive healing; how to get huge increases of [literacy](#); and uses of [plants](#) as medicines.

Nothing like this facility exists elsewhere. In Dar es Salaam, Tanzania the Institute of Traditional Healers in [Muhimbili University](#) is somewhat similar. The practical use of dreams and visions, and the neuroscience of suggestive healing are not taught there. Associations of Traditional Healers are found in numerous nations. Tanzania has the only one associated with a university or college so far. (A [sister organization](#) funds [herbal](#) studies there for [diabetes and AIDS](#).)

Purpose of the Bonds

The bond's proceeds pay for neurological research (to "rediscover" an ancient healing method) or capital improvements including renovations, upgrades and repairs of existing educational facilities on [our campus](#). It may include, but is not limited to: insulation, repair or replacement of lighting and electrical systems; heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems; flooring, roofs, doors, windows, walls; plumbing, painting, fixtures and accessories; communication, alarm, security, fire and sprinkler systems; fencing, and auditorium sound improvements; parking, handicap access improvements and therapeutic equipment. It also pays for asbestos abatement, installation of geothermal heat-sinks, solar power and heating and/or wind power to make our facility less dependent on increasingly expensive utilities; completion of CJZZ campus radio station, a 6 part documentary series, relevant translations, website software and a greenhouse to grow herbs that alleviate health related concerns, plus two timely technology challenges on [CPrize.org](#) (to solve problems related to transportation and future fossil fuel use; and untimely deaths to law enforcement with tasers and handguns) and our [Fun \(B⁴\) Literacy](#) program.

The Amount and Repayment of the Bonds

This bond may be purchased in two denominations, "A"=\$500, and "B"=\$1000. Principal returns on bonds are major societal benefits plus goods, services and/or interest. Bonds return a 7% rate of interest. Anyone can [purchase](#) our bonds. All Canadians can buy up to \$10,000; qualified investors may purchase more. [CPrize financials](#). Required capital: improvements/developments \$5 million, challenges \$40 million and B⁴ literacy \$255 million. [CIDA matches](#) 3-1 up to \$1.5 million of the funding raised for literacy projects, so purchases may add capital for us from other sources.

[In Canada, as a non-profit, our bonds are exempt from securities reporting under NI 45-106, Sec. 2-38. Bonds are repaid by sales of products and services, not by taxes (mill rate) or health insurance programs. Guarantees cannot be provided regarding repayment of "A" bonds, only assurances. "B" bonds are secured by properties owned by CPrize Foundation. Redemption of the bonds as goods and services prior to bond maturity date may require scheduling based on the purchase date. Installation date of the [hyperbaric chamber](#) has yet to be set. We cannot say how or if other jurisdictions regulate such purchases, however we do not discriminate against purchases from other nations.]
