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More Alarms for Japan,

My deepest sympathy for lives lost in your tragedy today. I must apologize for not having written much sooner. I knew in 1984 a huge earthquake and tsunami would occur in northern Japan, in the region of Sendai, but not when. Another massive earthquake, due in southern Japan (off Shikoku?), is at least as large. In addition, two unrelated mega-tsunamis devastate the whole of the eastern coast of Japan and their effects are not limited to the leading edge. Beyond that sketchy information I cannot say when or what magnitude the earthquakes are. You may ask how I know even this much, or disbelieve that anyone could know of such things in advance.

Overall the answer is simple, it's the practical use of dreams. Let me diverge slightly here to tell you a little about our program. Over many years we developed a method which enables interested people to know of life-threatening events in advance. By knowing where and what, and by using the motivated assistance of enough others, we can pinpoint the day, and what precautionary actions are required. Our primary objective is to reduce or eliminate the loss of lives. Property losses due to earthquakes and tsunamis might be reduced, not eliminated.

What you might want to also know is that the land in both the north and south of Japan will subside, again how much, what will need to be evacuated and when I cannot say yet. If you decide you want to know, and want to work towards preemptive solutions please get in touch. We have developed a series of books, a course and a website (English presently) to permit people to state their dreams. Obviously the content of dreams is rarely literal, however the analogical and figurative nature of them can be determined to provide conceptual information. Once we have sufficient input by people who have dreamed of such events, we can use the concepts to identify the specifics with certainty. With that, preemptive warnings can be provided of disasters, and other concerns if you choose to deal including subjects like creativity and health.

Our program, while aimed at preteen children, encourages anyone to input dreams for consideration. Children recall their dreams easiest and are less likely to describe anything other than what they see and experience. For preteen children there are benefits to doing this, huge increases in literacy. I recommend you see the 19 minute presentation on this, and read the links from the Powerpoint file to get a fuller understanding. It doesn't provide everything, but is certainly enough to comprehend the approach and potential results. I can say with certainty that by recording the content of dreams it enables people both within Japan and elsewhere to take preemptive action on their disaster dreams. Now is the perfect time to have people recall and record what their dreams are foreseeing by using images of current events to show future disaster(s) and what is needed to avoid losing lives in them. Intended meanings aren't like the opinions many psychologists have expressed on their use. At some point you will also need people trained in this method in order to have it work for the Japanese people, and that will entail having the written content translated into Japanese.

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Addendum:

Strong Suggestions:

1. Do not rebuild communities in coastal areas. Rebuild significantly damaged or destroyed communities on much higher ground. Where possible, rebuild above 400m in elevation (even that won't be high enough to avoid the destructive effects of the two mega-tsunamis coming from the Pacific. One is due in about 3-4 years and a following one may be several years later). Obviously recommendation suggests that all homes and businesses be built or moved well away from such events as soon as possible. Read the first page of www.commonwealthofpeace.com
2. Put more effort into developing and promptly implementing artificial tsunami barriers or 'walls' to diminish the magnitude of the shock waves in most affected shore areas, and in the volume of water tsunamis generate.
3. Spend at least half the annual cost of tsunami warnings on our program. The warnings will be much more useful and timely than any other method in existence. Scientific methods and related technology as good as it is have failed you. Half the cost of our program will return to children, and increase literacy in the same motion.

If these suggestions are ignored or not acted on the increase of lives lost and property damage will rise hugely. We cannot help those who claim to know more or disbelieve, and refuse to act in a judicious manner, especially as they do not know more about future events and their disbelief is simply creating an increased likelihood of ill-considered action and resulting failures.
