Public Service Announcement To Residents of Southern Saskatchewan/Northern Montana

Our non-profit Foundation exists to promote and apply dream information for practical purposes. The Creator supplies all of us with dreams and visions we can learn to use to our benefit. To many people that input to us is the Living Word (Numbers 12:6). Many well-known people in history have paved the way to this including Bell, Einstein, Edison, Tesla, plus inventive or creative people and Nobel Prize winners as well as all prophets of scriptures. One benefit dreams provide includes cautions and warnings of things that harm or endanger our lives or impair our success. **The following two points affect many as they involve life risks and/or property damage in our area within this year, likely this coming quarter.** We have time to act on these two cautions.

1. An earthquake larger than any in SK recorded history. What was seen was sufficient to severely damage the old building in which the Willow Bunch Museum is housed. We have seen the results of earthquakes in Haiti, Chile and Turkey on TV recently so we know what damage can be done. Earthquakes in Saskatchewan affect wide areas. This is the first of several even larger earthquakes in the next decade.
2. Associated with the earthquake is the emergence of a volcano to the south of us. How far away is still a matter of conjecture and could be as near as the US border or as far as the super volcano in Yellowstone Park. When the volcano does erupt there will be a slow moving, massive and dense cloud of ash which will settle and engulf our area as it passes by. Gasses within the cloud are poisonous. Protect livestock, get indoors and close all windows and doors until it passes. Note too, the electricity will have failed, probably due to damage created by the quake on the power plant in Coronach or on transmission lines.

Update added on April 16th: The volcano will be east of the Saskatchewan/Alberta/Montana border area, very close to the border, apparently in farmlands in the general vicinity (east) of Grasslands National Park. No existing volcanic feature exists where it appears.

The purpose of providing such information is so we can take reasoned actions to protect ourselves and property.
